The validity of this vendor approval is exist till the validity of submitted type test certificate. Apart from this the Model GTP & Drawing of the aforesaid material has already been approved which is being attached with this letter for your ready reference.

The Vendor will have to fulfill the required criteria of SBD/IS code & various tests to be conducted during pre-dispatch inspection.

As per the provision of SBD & REC D.O. Lr. No. REC/RDSS/Quality Assurance / FY 2022-23/ D.no. 6268 dated 03.07.2023, there are penalty provisions for the equipment /material supplied by the Turnkey Contractor (TKC)/Manufacturer/ Supplier that failed during the inspection and testing as per IS which are briefed below:-

- I. In case, a material supplied by the TKC failed during the Pre-Dispatch Inspection (PDI) and also failed in the subsequent repeat inspection of the rectified/replaced material, a complete lot of material under inspection will be required to be replaced by the manufacturer/supplier.
- II. If in the subsequent inspection of the new lot, the material again fails the inspection/testing, then materials shall be rejected, and **approval of vendor/sub-vendor shall also be cancelled for all RDSS projects.**

The penalty provision in case the materials picked up from DISCOM/PD site/store and tested at NABL Laboratory fails:-


- I. The entire lot of materials/equipment supplied by the defaulting manufacturer shall be rejected. All costs related to the removal of such rejected materials and reinstating a fresh lot of materials shall need to be borne by the turnkey contractor without any cost implication to the power utility.
- II. Actions shall be taken against the **willfully defaulted manufacturer and turnkey contractor or both.**

- III. Sub-vendors/vendor registration of the manufacturer shall be discontinued in all the power utilities of the country for a period of 5 years including in the power utility concerned where this act is found.
- IV. Turnkey contractor shall be responsible for repetitive failures of materials in field testing in a turnkey contract. In such situations, registration of turnkey contractor firms shall be discontinued in all the power utilities of the country for a period of 5 years including in the power utility concerned where this act is found.

In case any adverse report with regard to material/vendor arises at any stage, NBPDCCL reserves the right of withdrawal of the approval of the vendor with retrospective effect. The turn-key contractor in such case will be fully responsible to replace the whole materials at their own cost immediately. Approval of vendor shall be rejected at any time if any adverse report is received from any government utility in India or BSPHCL and its any subsidiary companies. The decision of NBPDCCL in this regard will be final.

This approval however does not absolve you from your liabilities under specific contract.
